Curriculum & Exam Pattern (PRT, TGT, PGT)

Introduction

The Teacher Recruitment Examination (TRE) is conducted by the Bihar Public Service Commission (BPSC) for the appointment of teachers in government schools of Bihar state. Under TRE 4.0 recruitment, appointments will be made for Primary Teacher (PRT), Trained Graduate Teacher (TGT), and Post Graduate Teacher (PGT) posts. This exam is organized to strengthen the quality education system in the schools of the state.

The official notification for the year 2026 is yet to be released. However, based on the previous exam structure, latest recruitment trends, and available exam calendar, the expected syllabus and exam pattern are presented below in detail. Approximately 46,595 posts are expected to be recruited in TRE 4.0.

The application process is likely to commence from March 2026 and the examination is expected to be conducted in September 2026 (Final confirmation will be from the official notification).
